

HOW TO PRINT THIS DOCUMENT AS AN A5 BOOKLET (USING A4 PAPER)

Definitions: "Sheets" refers to the actual sheets of A4 paper
"Pages" are the numbered pages of the finished booklet.

This instruction page need not be printed, but if you wish to do so select "Current page" on the Acrobat print dialogue box.

First print the first 4 double pages of the booklet - select "Pages [2] to [5]" on the Acrobat print dialog box (you need to enter the numbers shown in square brackets in the boxes provided).

You now need to place the paper back in the printer **so that the blank side of each sheet is ready to be printed on.**

IMPORTANT - Which way up is that? It will be either with the blank sides of each of the 4 sheets **facing up** or **facing down**.

You also need to make sure of the following 2 points:

A) That the paper is not rotated horizontally in transferring it back into the feed tray. Makes sure that the top edge of the A5 pages remain on the same side of your printer.

B) Make sure the sheets are in the following order in the tray:
Top sheet has pages 10 & 7 on the other side;
Second sheet has pages 12 & 5 on the other side;
Third sheet has pages 14 & 3 on the other side;
Bottom sheet has page 16 & the front cover on the other side.

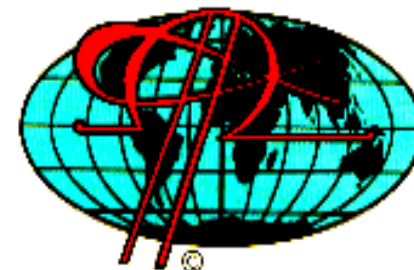
You are now ready to print the last 4 double pages of the booklet - select "Pages [6] to [9]" on the Acrobat print dialog box.

Now make sure that all the pages are now in the following order:

Bottom sheet front cover & page 16 facing down, page 2 & 15 facing upwards;
Next sheet pages 3 & 14 down, pages 4 & 13 up;
Next sheet pages 5 & 12 down, pages 6 & 11 up;
Top sheet pages 7 & 10 down, pages 8 & 9 up.

Finally, carefully fold all 4 sheets along the vertical centre line and staple in the crease if desired.

N.B. If you want to make several copies of this guide for use in a study group, you can either print the required number from your printer, or print a master copy and then photocopy multiple copies. If you chose this second option we recommend that you simply select "Print pages [2] to [9]" in the Acrobat print dialogue box and then make sure the backs and fronts of each sheet are correctly matched.

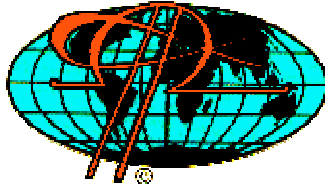

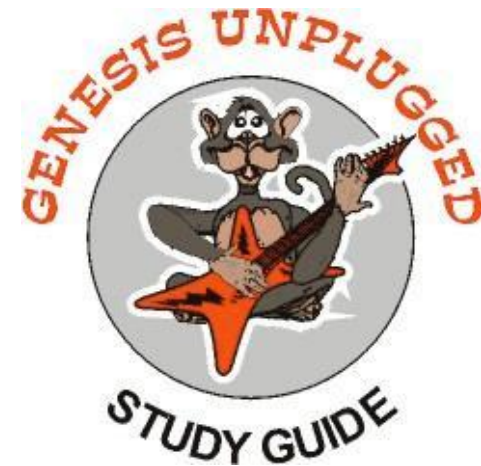
