"The LORD sat enthroned at the Flood"

Greek: 'kataklusmos' [2626/2627] **5 times in New Testament**

Septuagint translates 'mabbuwl' with 'kataclusmos'

Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming. But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.

And as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man: They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all.

Likewise as it was also in the days of Lot: They ate, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they built; but on the day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven and destroyed them all.

Even so will it be in the day when the Son of Man is revealed.

In that day, he who is on the housetop, and his goods are in the house, let him not come down to take them away. And likewise the one who is in the field, let him not turn back.

Remember Lot's wife. Whoever seeks to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life will preserve it.



This is the only passage in the Bible which records that Noah preached as well as built!

Preparing for the Future - Lessons from Noah Genesis 5:28-30

Lamech lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and had a son. And he called his name Noah, saying, "This one will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD has cursed."

After he begot Noah, Lamech lived five hundred and ninety-five years, and had sons and daughters.

Noah was not discouraged when his brothers and sisters rejected his warnings!

Ps 95:7-11 & Heb 3:7-4:11 are both about entering into The LORD's rest which is promised to those who believe & obey Him.

Preparing for the Future - Lessons from Noah Psalm 95

Oh come, let us sing to the LORD! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms. For the LORD is the great God, and the great King above all gods.

In His hand are the deep places of the earth; The heights of the hills are His also. The sea is His, for He made it; and His hands formed the dry land. Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.

For He is our God, and we are the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand.

Preparing for the Future - Lessons from Noah Psalm 95

Today, if you will hear His voice: do not harden your hearts, as in the rebellion, as in the day of trial in the wilderness, when your fathers tested Me; they tried Me, though they saw My work.

For forty years I was grieved with that generation, And said, 'It is a people who go astray in their hearts, And they do not know My ways.' So I swore in My wrath, 'They shall not enter My rest.'

When Noah heard The LORD's voice, he did not harden His heart and rebel.

Noah believed God, obeyed Him and entered into His rest.

When judgement came upon society, He was already in the place of safety and deliverance.
