- :1-4 Abram returns from Egypt to Bethel a very rich man;
- Lot also many possessions and there wasn't enough space for them both;
 Trouble broke out between there herdsmen;
 Abram not wanting there to be arguments asked Lot to go his separate way, and said he would allow Lot to choose first.

Genesis 13:10-13

And Lot lifted his eyes and saw all the plain of Jordan, that it was well watered everywhere (before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah) like the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt as you go toward Zoar.

Genesis 14

Five kings, including the Kings of Sodom and Gomorrah, rebelled against their overlords.

The outcome v10:

Now the Valley of Siddim was full of asphalt pits; and the kings of Sodom and Gomorrah fled; some fell there, and the remainder fled to the mountains.

Preparing for the Future - Warnings from Lot Genesis 14

v11-12 "Then they took all the goods of Sodom and Gomorrah, and all their provisions, and went their way.

They also took Lot, Abram's brother's son who dwelt in Sodom, and his goods, and departed."

News of Lot's capture reaches Abram and he defeats the captors, rescues Lot and all the people of these cities.

This passage is best known for Abram's encounter with Melchizedek, king of Salem, who is identified in Hebrews 7 as a type of Jesus.

Abram is also offered all the wealth of Sodom by its king, but he refuses to take it, but asks that those who fought with him might receive their portion.

There is no other mention of Lot in this chapter.

Preparing for the Future - Warnings from Lot Genesis 19

- :1-3 Lot invites the two angels to stay with him.
- :4-5 Men of all ages demand that Lot sends the "men" out so they can have sex with them.
- :6-8 Lot offers his two unmarried daughters as alternatives.
- The people not only reject his trade, but also reject him:

 "This one came in to stay here, and he keeps acting as a judge; now we will deal worse with you than with them."

- :10-11 The angles pull Lot back into the house and then strike the attackers with blindness.
- :12-14 The angels ask Lot if he has any relatives who he needed to warn to leave before they destroy the city.

"So it came to pass, when they had brought them outside, that he said, 'Escape for your life! Do not look behind you nor stay anywhere in the plain. Escape to the mountains, lest you be destroyed."

"Then Lot said to them, 'Please, no, my lords! Indeed now, your servant has found favour in your sight, and you have increased your mercy which you have shown me by saving my life; but I cannot escape to the mountains, lest some evil overtake me and I die.

"See now, this city is near enough to flee to, and it is a little one; please let me escape there (is it not a little one?) and my soul shall live."

- "And he said to him, 'See, I have favoured you concerning this thing also, in that I will not overthrow this city for which you have spoken. Hurry, escape there. For I cannot do anything until you arrive there.' Therefore the name of the city was called Zoar. [Little] The sun had risen upon the earth when Lot entered Zoar.

The Hebrew appears to offer very little help as it is the context which supplies the tense rather than the words.

Preparing for the Future - Warnings from Lot

Possible objections to my suggestion

In 19:30-38, Lot's two daughters are described as "the firstborn" and "the younger."

This will suggest to some that they were the only two daughters, but it was not necessarily the case:

It could simply mean "the older one" and "the younger one" of the two;

Or that the eldest daughter and one of her younger sisters survived.

Preparing for the Future - Warnings from Lot Possible objections to my suggestion

This same comparison is also made in two other families:

Ge 29:26 "And Laban said, 'It must not be done so in our country, to give the younger before the firstborn."

1Sa 14:49 "The sons of Saul were Jonathan, Jishui and Malchishua. And the names of his two daughters were these: the name of the firstborn Merab, and the name of the younger Michal."

Both these men also had sons (see Gen. 31:1 & 2 Sam. 21:1–11) and there is no information given about the order of birth between the sons and the daughters.

Preparing for the Future - Warnings from Lot

Why did Lot's wife look back? Why did Lot linger?

My suggestion is that they were leaving at least two daughters (and perhaps grandchildren) behind to be destroyed!

That makes most sense of Jesus warning.

Preparing for the Future - Warnings from Lot Genesis 19

- :27-28 Abraham observes the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah.
- :29 God drove Lot out of Sodom for Abraham's sake.
- :30 Lot finally obeys The LORD and leaves Zoar for the mountains.
- :31-36 He is so unprepared that his daughters have to make him drunk, so that they can conceive children.
- :37-38 The children are Moab and Ben-Ammi, from whom the Moabites and the Ammonites are descended. (Deut 2:19)
