Old Testament (Part 2)

1 Samuel 28:7-19

Then Saul said to his servants, "Find me a woman who is a medium, that I may go to her and inquire of her." And his servants said to him, "In fact, there is a woman who is a medium at En Dor." So Saul disguised himself and put on other clothes, and he went, and two men with him; and they came to the woman by night. And he said, "Please conduct a séance for me, and bring up for me the one I shall name to you." Then the woman said to him, "Look, you know what Saul has done, how he has cut off the mediums and the spiritists from the land. Why then do you lay a snare for my life, to cause me to die?" And Saul swore to her by The LORD, saying, "As The LORD lives, no punishment shall come upon you for this thing."

Then the woman said, "Whom shall I *bring up* for you?" And he said, "*Bring up* Samuel for me." When the woman saw Samuel, she cried out with a loud voice. And the woman spoke to Saul, saying, "Why have you deceived me? For you are Saul!" And the king said to her, "Do not be afraid. What did you see?" And the woman said to Saul, "I saw a spirit ascending out of the earth." So he said to her, "What is his form?" And she said, "An old man is coming up, and he is covered with a mantle." And Saul perceived that it was Samuel, and he stooped with his face to the ground and bowed down.

Now Samuel said to Saul, "Why have you disturbed* me by bringing me up?" And Saul answered, "I am deeply distressed; for the Philistines make war against me, and God has departed from me and does not answer me anymore, neither by prophets nor by dreams. Therefore I have called you, that you may reveal to me what I should do." Then Samuel said: "So why do you ask me, seeing The LORD has departed from you and has become your enemy? And The LORD has done for Himself as He spoke by me. For The LORD has torn the kingdom out of your hand and given it to your neighbour, David. Because you did not obey the voice of The LORD nor execute His fierce wrath upon Amalek, therefore The LORD has done this thing to you this day. Moreover The LORD will also deliver Israel with you into the hand of the Philistines. And tomorrow you and your sons will be with me. The Lord will also deliver the army of Israel into the hand of the Philistines."

Daniel 12:1-2

John 11:11-14

- 11 These things He said, and after that He said to them, "Our friend Lazarus <u>sleeps</u>, but I go that I may wake him up."
- 12 Then His disciples said, "Lord, if he sleeps he will get well."
- 13 However, Jesus spoke of his death, but they thought that He was speaking about taking rest in sleep.
- 14 Then Jesus said to them plainly, "Lazarus is dead."

John 12:20-26

- 20 Now there were certain Greeks among those who came up to worship at the feast.
- 21 Then they came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida of Galilee, and asked him, saying, "Sir, we wish to see Jesus."
- 22 Philip came and told Andrew, and in turn Andrew and Philip told Jesus.
- 23 But Jesus answered them, saying, "The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified.
- 24 Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain.
- 25 He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.
- 26 If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will honour."

John 14:1-4

- 1 "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.
- 2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. <u>I go to prepare a place for you.</u>
- 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.
- 4 And where I go you know, and the way you know."

John 17:20-26

- 20 "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word;
- 21 that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.
- 22 And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one:
- 23 I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.
- 24 Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me <u>may be with Me where I am</u>, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.
- 25 O righteous Father! The world has not known You, but I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me.
- 26 And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare it, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them."

Luke 23:39-46

- 39 Then one of the criminals who were hanged blasphemed Him, saying, "If You are the Christ, save Yourself and us."
- 40 But the other, answering, rebuked him, saying, "Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation?
- 41 "And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong."
- 42 Then he said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom."
- 43 And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."

- 44 Now it was about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour.
- 45 Then the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was torn in two.
- 46 And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, "Father, 'into Your hands <u>I commit My spirit*</u>." Having said this, He breathed His last.

Acts 7:57-60

- 57 Then they cried out with a loud voice, stopped their ears, and ran at him [Stephen] with one accord;
- 58 and they cast him out of the city and stoned him. And the witnesses laid down their clothes at the feet of a young man named Saul.
- 59 And they stoned Stephen as he was calling on God and saying, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit."
- 60 Then he knelt down and cried out with a loud voice, "Lord, do not charge them with this sin." And when he had said this, he fell asleep.

Philippians 1:21-26

- 21 For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain.
- 22 But if I live on in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my labour; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell.
- 23 For I am hard pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better.
- 24 Nevertheless to remain in the flesh is more needful for you.
- 25 And being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy of faith,
- 26 that your rejoicing for me may be more abundant in Jesus Christ by my coming to you again.

2 Corinthians 5:1-11

- 1 For we know that if our earthly house, this tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.
- 2 For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed with our habitation which is from heaven,
- 3 if indeed, having been clothed, we shall not be found naked.
- 4 For we who are in this tent groan, being burdened, not because we want to be unclothed, but further clothed, that mortality may be swallowed up by life.
- 5 Now He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who also has given us the Spirit as a guarantee.
- 6 So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from The LORD
- 7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.
- 8 We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with The LORD.
- 9 Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him.
- 10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.
- 11 Knowing, therefore, the terror of The LORD, we persuade men; but we are well known to God, and I also trust are well known in your consciences.

Revelation 6:9-11

- 9 When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls* of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held.
- 10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"

- 11 Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed.

Revelation 7:9-17

- 9 After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands,
- 10 and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"
- 11 All the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshipped God,
- 12 saying: "Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom, Thanksgiving and honour and power and might, Be to our God forever and ever. Amen."
- 13 Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?"
- 14 And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
- 15 Therefore they are before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them.
- 16 They shall neither hunger anymore nor thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any heat;
- 17 for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of waters. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."

Mt 12:18* "Behold! My Servant whom I have chosen, My Beloved in whom My soul is well pleased! I will put My Spirit upon Him, And He will declare justice to the Gentiles.

Spirit H7307 ruwach; from 07306; wind; by resemblance breath, i.e. a sensible (or even violent) exhalation;...

H7306 ruwach; a primitive root; properly, to blow, i.e. breathe;...
